A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO HEALTH.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that recent neuroscience research demonstrates that a child's early years are the most 2 3 crucial in the child's cognitive, emotional, social, and 4 physical development. The legislature further finds that early screening of 5 hearing and vision related medical problems improve children's 6 outcomes and has a critical influence on school success and 7 family functioning. As not all children have access to quality 8 primary health care, it is in the State's interest to provide 9 10 screening and assessment that will detect hearing and vision 11 deficiencies to identify children who are in need of further evaluation, diagnosis, and treatment. Early identification and 12 13 treatment can prevent or at least alleviate many of the problems

The department of health currently provides various community health screening services. The purpose of this Act is to expand these services to provide screening for hearing and

- 12 department of education, and community service organizations,
- 13 which may include the International Association of Lions Clubs,
- 14 and Rotary Clubs, in order to carry out the hearing and vision
- 15 screening required under this Act.
- 16 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2008.
