A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO INSURANCE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the accessibility 1

and affordability of proper dental services is a continuing 2

3 problem in this State. The lack of good dental care can lead to

other more serious health problems, ultimately resulting in 4

higher medical costs and deteriorating health conditions. While 5

access is not a problem unique to Hawaii, it is imperative that 6

solutions be adopted and implemented in order to prevent further 7

8 decline.

9 One way to improve access to dental care is to give

patients the option of going to their practitioner of choice --

11 the dentist that they know and trust. Currently, this is not

possible if that dentist is not a participant in the patient's

health insurance plan. Often under such circumstances, the 13

patient would have to pay the dentist first and wait to receive 14

reimbursement from the insurer. In most cases, the amount 15

reimbursed is less than the amount that would have been paid if

the dentist was a participating dentist. 17

- 1 The situation becomes even more critical when a patient 2 needs to be seen by a specialist, especially in an emergency, but is limited to seeing only a specialist who is a participant 3 4 in that patient's health insurance plan. This requirement can 5 result in delays, additional pain and discomfort, and increased risk to the patient. 6 7 The purpose of this Act is to enhance the patient's access 8 to quality dental care, without increasing costs to the insurer 9 or the patient, by permitting patients to select their dentists 10 and allowing patients the option of having their insurance 11 reimbursement sent directly to the dentist of choice. 12 SECTION 2. Chapter 431, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 13 amended by adding a new section to article 10A to be 14 appropriately designated and to read as follows: 15 "\$431:10A- Dental services; reimbursement. (a) An 16 insured may assign reimbursement for dental services directly to 17 the provider of services. 18 Upon notification by the insured, the insurer shall 19 reimburse the provider for dental services provided to the insured, regardless of whether the provider is a 20

nonparticipating provider with the insurer.
