## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO NOISE.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 291-24, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 2 amended to read as follows:
- 3 "\$291-24 Motorcycles and mopeds, noisy mufflers; penalty.
- 4 (a) Every motorcycle and moped moving under its own power on a
- 5 public highway shall [at all times] be equipped with a muffler
- 6 in constant operation to prevent any excessive or unusual noise
- 7 [and no such]; except a motorcycle or moped that:
- 8 (1) Has three wheels;
- 9 (2) Is powered by an electric motor;
- 10 (3) Has a full body enclosed cab; and
- 11 (4) Has a seat belt assembly or a child restraint system
- for the driver and passenger.
- (b) No muffler or exhaust system under this section shall
- 14 be equipped with a cutout, bypass, or similar device.
- 15 (c) No person shall modify the exhaust system of a
- 16 motorcycle or a moped in a manner [which will amplify or
- 17 increase] that amplifies or increases the noise emitted by the

- 3 [which will] or an exhaust pipe that noticeably [increase]
