A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO NOISE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- SECTION 1. Section 291-24, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is amended to read as follows: "5291-24 Motorcycles and mopeds, noisy mufflers; penalty.
- 4 (a) Every motorcycle and moped moving under its own power on a
- 5 public highway shall [at all times] be equipped with a muffler
- 6 in constant operation to prevent any excessive or unusual noise
- 7 [and no such]; except a motorcycle or moped that:
- 8 (1) Has three wheels;
- 9 (2) Is powered by an electric motor;
- 10 (3) Has a full body enclosed cab; and
- 11 (4) Has a seat belt assembly or a child restraint system

 12 for the driver and passenger.
- (b) No muffler or exhaust system under this section shall
- 14 be equipped with a cutout, bypass, or similar device.
- 15 $\underline{\text{(c)}}$ No person shall modify the exhaust system of a
- 16 motorcycle or a moped in a manner [which will amplify or
- 17 increase] that amplifies or increases the noise emitted by the

- 1 motor of [such] the motorcycle or moped above that emitted by
- 2 the muffler originally installed on the motorcycle or moped
- 3 [except a motorcycle or moped that:
- 4 (1) Has three wheels;
- 5 (2) Is powered by an electric motor,
- 6 (3) Has a full body enclosed cab; and
- 7 (4) Has a seat belt assembly or a child restraint system
- 9 shall not be required to be equipped with a muffler].
- 10 [\(\frac{(b)}{}\)] (d) As used in this section, "muffler" means a
- 11 device consisting of a series of chambers or baffle plates, or
- 12 other mechanical design, for the purpose of receiving exhaust
- 13 gas from the engine of the motorcycle or moped, and being
- 14 effective in reducing noise.
- 15 [(c)] (e) Whoever violates the provisions of this section
- 16 applicable to motorcycles shall be fined not more than \$100.
- 17 (f) Whoever violates the provisions of this section
- 18 applicable to mopeds shall be fined:
- 19 (1) \$50 for the first violation;
- 20 (2) \$75 for the second violation; and
- 21 (3) \$250 for a third or subsequent violation."

- 1 SECTION 2. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
- 2 matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
- 3 begun, before its effective date.
- 4 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 5 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 6 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2050.
