RELATING TO CAREGIVER RECOGNITION DAY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 8, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is amended
- 2 by adding a new section to be appropriately designated and to
- 3 read as follows:
- 4 "§8- Caregiver recognition day. The first Saturday of
- 5 November shall be known and designated as caregiver recognition
- 6 day, in recognition of the very significant role that caregivers
- 7 play in support of Hawaii's elderly and persons with
- 8 disabilities. This day is not and shall not be construed as a
- 9 state holiday.
- 10 As used in this section: "caregiver" means any person who
- 11 has undertaken the care, custody, or physical assistance of an
- 12 elderly or disabled person, including but not limited to
- 13 compensated or uncompensated family members or other relatives,
- 14 or any person who has a legal or contractual duty, or desire to
- 15 care for the health, safety, and welfare of an elderly or
- 16 disabled person, including but not limited to the owners,
- 17 operators, employees, and staff of long-term care facilities and
- 18 community home based institutions."
