## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO EDUCATION.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that first-hand knowledge 2 of other cultures, along with learning opportunities in foreign countries, can help prepare students to fully participate in 3 today's global economy. Additionally, Hawaii students and 4 faculty who participate in foreign exchange programs foster 5 6 goodwill, cultural interaction, and positive international 7 relationships between the State of Hawaii and foreign countries. 8 Currently, the State of Hawaii has a sister state 9 relationship with four prefectures in Japan: Fukuoka, Okinawa, Hiroshima, and Ehime. The Hawaii-Okinawa Student Exchange 10 Program, which has been in existence for seventeen years, is an 11 12 example of a cost-effective and beneficial program that fosters global awareness and cross-cultural exchange among today's 13 14 youth. 15 A similar exchange program between Hawaii and the Philippines would strengthen an already mutually beneficial 16

relationship between Hawaii and the Philippines, with whom the

State has had a long history of cultural, social, and economic

- 1 ties. For example, the State of Hawaii in 2006 commemorated the
- 2 centennial of Filipino migration to Hawaii and officials from
- 3 the Republic of the Philippines have expressed a strong interest
- 4 in developing student exchange programs with Hawaii. The State
- 5 of Hawaii currently has a sister state relationship with five
- 6 provinces in the Philippines: Ilocos Sur, Cebu, Pangasinan,
- 7 Ilocos Norte, and Isabela.
- 8 The purpose of this Act is to develop a student and faculty
- 9 exchange program with Hawaii's sister provinces in the
- 10 Philippines to foster global awareness, promote cultural
- 11 exchange, and provide cross-cultural learning opportunities
- 12 among Hawaii's youth, faculty, and educational communities.
- 13 SECTION 2. The department of education shall develop,
- 14 plan, and implement a student and faculty exchange program with
- 15 Hawaii's sister state provinces in the Republic of the
- 16 Philippines. The department shall consult with the University
- 17 of Hawaii, the Hawaii Association of Independent Schools, and
- 18 various Filipino community organizations such as the United
- 19 Filipino Council of Hawaii, Filipino Chamber of Commerce,
- 20 Congress of Visayan Organizations, and others in the
- 21 development, planning, and implementation of the student and

- 1 faculty exchange program. The program shall be implemented no
- 2 later than the 2010-2011 school year.
- 3 SECTION 3. The department of education shall submit a
- 4 report to the legislature of its findings and recommendations on
- 5 the status of the development, implementation, and maintenance
- 6 of a student and faculty exchange program between Hawaii and its
- 7 sister provinces in the Republic of the Philippines no later
- 8 than twenty days prior to the convening of the regular session
- **9** of 2009.
- 10 SECTION 4. There is appropriated out of the general
- 11 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ , or so much
- 12 thereof as may be necessary, for fiscal year 2008-2009 for the
- 13 development and implementation of a student and faculty exchange
- 14 program between Hawaii and its sister provinces in the Republic
- 15 of the Philippines.
- 16 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
- 17 education for the purposes of this Act.
- 18 SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2008.
