## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO WATER SUPPLY.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that Hawaii's drinking
- 2 water is a vital necessity of life and should be maintained free
- 3 of any chemicals, except those necessary to make it safe for
- 4 human consumption. Drinking water should not be used as a means
- 5 for delivery of chemicals for medical or dental purposes. The
- 6 purpose of this Act is to prohibit the introduction of chemicals
- 7 into Hawaii's water supply.
- 8 SECTION 2. Section 340E-7, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 9 amended to read as follows:
- 10 "§340E-7 Prohibited acts. (a) No supplier of water shall
- 11 violate any rule adopted pursuant to section 340E-2.
- 12 (b) No supplier of water shall violate any condition or
- 13 provision of a variance, exemption, permit, or other written
- 14 authorization issued under this part.
- 15 (c) No supplier of water shall violate any requirement of
- 16 an emergency plan promulgated pursuant to section 340E-5.

- 1 (d) No supplier of water shall violate any rule adopted
- 2 under section 340E-6 or disseminate any false or misleading
- 3 information with respect to notices required pursuant to
- 4 section 340E-6 or with respect to remedial actions undertaken to
- 5 achieve compliance with state primary drinking water
- 6 regulations.
- 7 (e) No person shall violate any order issued by the
- 8 director pursuant to this part.
- 9 (f) No person shall cause a public water system to violate
- 10 the state primary drinking water regulations.
- 11 (q) No person shall violate underground injection control
- 12 rules adopted pursuant to this part.
- (h) No person shall fail or refuse to comply with the
- 14 director's authority to inspect the premises of a supplier of
- 15 water pursuant to section 340E-4.6.
- (i) No person shall install or repair any public water
- 17 system or any plumbing in a residential or nonresidential
- 18 facility providing water for human consumption which is
- 19 connected to a public water system with any pipe, solder, flux,
- 20 plumbing fittings, or fixtures that are not lead free. "Lead
- 21 free" with respect to solders and flux means containing not more
- 22 than 0.2 per cent lead, with respect to pipes and pipe fittings



- 1 means containing not more than 8.0 per cent lead and with
- 2 respect to plumbing fittings and fixtures means those in
- 3 compliance with National Sanitation Foundation Standard 61,
- 4 section 9. This subsection shall not apply to leaded joints
- 5 necessary for the repair of cast iron pipes.
- 6 (j) No person shall violate rules on public water system
- 7 capacity adopted pursuant to this part.
- 8 (k) No person shall add any product, substance or chemical
- 9 to the public water supply for the purpose of treating or
- 10 affecting the physical or mental functions of the body of any
- 11 person, rather than to make water safe or potable."
- 12 SECTION 3. New statutory material is underscored.
- 13 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
