## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE AFTER-SCHOOL PLUS PROGRAM REVOLVING FUND.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the purpose of the after-school plus program revolving fund is to ensure that the program participant fees are used to support the program. The legislature further finds that the program is also supported by general fund appropriations and funds from the department of
- 6 human services for child care for eligible low-income children.
- 7 The purpose of this Act is to require that the funds
- 8 deposited into the after-school plus program revolving fund are
- 9 only those funds that are collected as fees or charges for
- 10 participation in the after-school plus program and interest
- 11 earned on the revolving fund deposits and investments.
- 12 SECTION 2. Section 302A-1149.5, Hawaii Revised Statutes,
- 13 is amended to read as follows:
