RELATING TO CHILDREN.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that an estimated six 2 thousand children in the State of Hawaii have a parent in Many children of incarcerated parents experience grief, 3 quilt, shame, fear, depression, and have difficulty sleeping or 4 concentrating. Although children need to maintain contact with 5 6 their parent, visits at correctional facilities can be 7 frightening for some children. 8 The purpose of this Act is to help maintain the well-being 9 of children of incarcerated parents and support their needs. 10 SECTION 2. Chapter 346, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 11 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated 12 and to read as follows: 13 Bill of rights for children of incarcerated "§346-14 Children of incarcerated parents shall be afforded 15 rights, which shall include the right:
- To be kept safe and informed at the time of the 16 (1)17 parent's arrest;
