A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO PROSTITUTION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. (a) The department of human services shall
- 2 contract the services of a health and human services provider to
- 3 fund a program that would coordinate agencies with a
- 4 demonstrated capacity of addressing the issues related to youth
- 5 at risk, who may become involved in prostitution and other
- 6 potentially harmful activities incident to that lifestyle. The
- 7 problem of addressing the needs of youth currently involved in
- 8 prostitution with an emphasis on assisting those exiting should
- 9 also be part of this program. The contract shall be executed in
- 10 accordance with chapter 103F, Hawaii Revised Statutes.
- 11 (b) The agency contracted by the department of human
- 12 services to establish the program shall submit an interim
- 13 report, including any proposed legislation, to the legislature
- 14 no later than twenty days prior to the convening of the 2009
- 15 regular session, and a final report, including any proposed
- 16 legislation, to the legislature no later than twenty days prior
- 17 to the convening of the 2010 regular session.

- 1 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
- 2 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$300,000 or so much
- 3 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2008-2009 for the
- 4 department of human services to implement a prostitution
- 5 prevention education and diversion program.
- 6 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
- 7 human services for the purposes of this Act.
- 8 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2008.
