A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO EDUCATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that fine arts curriculum
- 2 includes visual arts, music, chorus, drama, band, and dance.
- 3 Funds have been diverted from classes in the fine arts to
- 4 classes in what are identified as essential courses by the No
- 5 Child Left Behind Act of 2001, Public Law 107-110.
- 6 According to the United States Department of Education,
- 7 college bound junior high school students should take classes in
- 8 the fine arts as "[m] any colleges view participation in the arts
- 9 and music as a valuable experience that broadens students'
- 10 understanding and appreciation of the world around them."
- 11 The purpose of this Act is to appropriate additional funds
- 12 to the department of education to be used for the development,
- 13 renewal, and maintenance of classes in the fine arts or
- 14 performing arts programs or courses at the secondary school
- 15 level.
- 16 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
- 17 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so

- 13 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of

- 15 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2008.
