A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO ESTABLISHING A GLOBAL YOUTH CENTER.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. World peace is a major collaborative goal and 1 youth are the key to attaining world peace, environmental 2 sustainability, and human and economic productivity for future 3 generations. Hawaii's location at the center of the Pacific rim 4 region between Asia and the Americas, its diverse culture, and 5 its many shared languages provide an excellent strategic forum 6 for meetings and exchanges, as demonstrated by the Millennium 7 Youth People's Congress that was held in Hawaii in October 1999. 8 9 This Act is consistent with the bylaws of the Global Youth Center, Inc., and Global Youth Center of Hawaii, and with the 10 vision statement of a major Global Youth Center contributor, the 11 12 International Student/Young Pugwash, to address our global 13 society threats from nuclear weapons and nuclear proliferation, 14 as well as social, economic, and environmental problems that put human security at risk. This Act is further consistent with the 15 vision to effectively address our global society threats from **16** 17 international conflict and violence. New tools and methods need

- 1 to be developed with an interdisciplinary framework to actively
- 2 search for and realize sustainable and equitable solutions. To
- 3 this end, the people of the world, particularly youth, must
- 4 learn to think and act collaboratively in new ways.
- 5 The purpose of this Act is to establish a global youth
- 6 center in Hawaii under the University of Hawaii.
- 7 SECTION 2. Chapter 304A, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 8 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
- 9 and to read as follows:
- 10 "§304A- Global youth center; establishment. (a) There
- 11 is established a global youth center within and in collaboration
- 12 with the University of Hawaii. The global youth center is
- 13 established for educational purposes, to support collaboration
- 14 linking Hawaii youth with people around the world, working
- 15 together to discover creative ways to develop the global future,
- 16 and help shape a more peaceful and healthier earth. The global
- 17 youth center shall generate and link an international framework
- 18 in which youth from around the world may become actively engaged
- 19 in the attainment of world peace, environmental sustainability,
- 20 and human and economic productivity for future generations.
