A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO HIGHWAY SAFETY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Chapter 286, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended by adding three new sections to be appropriately
3	designated and to read as follows:
4	"§286-A Definitions. (a) As used in this chapter:
5	"All-terrain vehicle" means a motor vehicle that:
6	(1) Is designed for operation off of the highway by an
7	operator with no more than one passenger;
8	(2) If fifty inches or less in width;
9	(3) Weighs nine hundred pounds or less without load;
10	(4) Is suspended on three or more tires;
11	(5) Has a single seat designed to be straddled by the
12	operator, or a single seat designed to be straddled by
13	the operator and a seat for not more than one
14	passenger; and
15	(6) Has handlebars for steering control.
16	"Minor" means a person under the age of eighteen.
17	"Wear a safety helmet" means having a safety helmet that:

    (a) No minor shall operate, ride, or otherwise be propelled on
    an all-terrain vehicle unless the minor wears a safety helmet.

         (b) No person shall lease, rent, loan, or sell an

    all-terrain vehicle to a minor unless the person furnishes a

    safety helmet for the minor operating the all-terrain vehicle.
