A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE WIRELESS ENHANCED 911 BOARD.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the wireless 2 enhanced 911 board is unique among state boards and commissions 3 by allowing a guorum to be established either in person or by 4 proxy, and allowing a member to vote by written proxy submitted to the board. According to the posted minutes for the monthly 5 6 meetings held from January through November 2007, proxy 7 designations were assigned at all eleven meetings. The 8 legislature further finds that of the six members required for a 9 quorum, three of the six members are statutorily required to be 10 representatives of the wireless providers and three are 11 statutorily required to be representatives of public safety 12 answering points. Allowing a vote by proxy, while requiring 13 specific representation, is contrary to the intent of 14 representation.

15 The purpose of this Act is to require that quorum be met by 16 a member's physical presence at a meeting, to permit quorum to



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be met by the physical presence of any six members of the board, 1 2 and to delete the proxy authorization for quorum and for voting. SECTION 2. Section 138-2, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 3 amended to read as follows: 4 "§138-2 Wireless enhanced 911 board. (a) 5 There is 6 created within the department of accounting and general 7 services, for administrative purposes, a wireless enhanced 911 8 board consisting of eleven voting members; provided that the 9 membership shall consist of: 10 The comptroller or the comptroller's designee; (1)11 Three representatives from wireless providers, who (2)shall be appointed by the governor as provided in 12 13 section 26-34, except as otherwise provided by law; One representative each from the public safety 14 (3) 15 answering points for Oahu, Hawaii, Kauai, Maui, and Molokai, who shall be appointed by the governor, as 16 17 provided in section 26-34, except as otherwise provided by law, from a list of five names submitted 18 by each respective public safety answering point; 19 The consumer advocate or the consumer advocate's 20 (4) 21 designee; and



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1 (5) One representative of the current wireline provider of enhanced 911. 2 3 Six members [either in person or by prexy, pursuant to (b) subsection (g),] shall constitute a quorum, whose affirmative 4 5 vote shall be necessary for all actions by the board [; provided 6 that three of the six members constituting a quorum shall be 7 representatives of the wireless providers and three shall be representatives of public safety answering points, except as 8 9 provided in section 138-8(c)]. 10 (c) The chairperson of the board shall be elected by the members of the board by simple majority and shall serve a term 11 12 of one year. 13 (d) The board shall meet upon the call of the chairperson, 14 but not less than guarterly. 15 The members representing wireless providers shall be (e) appointed by the governor for terms of two years, except that 16 terms of the two members initially appointed shall be for 17 18 eighteen months. (f) Each member shall hold office until the member's 19 20 successor is appointed and qualified. Section 26-34 shall apply 21 only insofar as it relates to succession, vacancies, and 22 suspension of board members, and as provided in subsection (a). SB2258 SD1 LRB 08-1709.doc

2	the board.
3	(h) (g) The members shall serve without compensation.
4	Members shall be entitled to reimbursements from the wireless
5	enhanced 911 fund for reasonable traveling expenses incurred in
6	connection with the performance of board duties.
7	$\left[\frac{(i)}{(i)}\right]$ (h) The board or its chairperson, with the approval
8	of the board, may retain independent, third-party accounting
9	firms, consultants, or other third party to:
10	(1) Create reports, make payments into the fund, process
11	checks, and make distributions from the fund, as
12	directed by the board and as allowed by this chapter;
13	and
14	(2) Perform administrative duties necessary to administer
15	the fund or oversee operations of the board, including
16	providing technical advisory support.
17	$\left[\frac{(j)}{(j)}\right]$ (i) The board shall develop reasonable procedures to
18	ensure that all wireless providers receive adequate notice of
19	board meetings and information concerning board decisions."
20	SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
21	and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
22	SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
