- 1 SECTION 1. Section 281-60, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows:
- 3 Except as provided for in section 281-13, if an
- applicant has at any time been denied or refused a license, no 4
- 5 further application from the applicant pertaining to the same
- 6 premises or building location shall be considered for [one year]
- 7 three years from the denial or refusal."
- 8 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 9 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 10 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2008.
