A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO HISTORIC PRESERVATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 46, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is amended 2 by adding a new section to be appropriately designated and to read as follows: 3 4 "§46- County building permit fees; historic 5 preservation. Notwithstanding any other law to the contrary, each county agency that issues building, construction, or 6 development-related permits shall establish a procedure to 7 8 withhold four per cent of all fees collected for building, 9 construction, and development-related county permits and deposit 10 the collected fees into the Hawaii historic preservation fund 11 under section 6E-16." SECTION 2. Section 6E-16, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 12 13 amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows: 14 "(a) There is established a Hawaii historic preservation 15 special fund into which shall be deposited the following moneys: 16 Appropriations by the legislature to the special fund; (1)
- (2) Gifts, donations, and grants from public agencies and 17 18 private persons;
