A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO MOTOR VEHICLE INSURANCE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAH:

- SECTION 1. Chapter 431, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is

 amended by adding a new section to article 10C to be

 appropriately designated and to read as follows:

 "S431:10C- Reduction in premium charges; insureds fifty
 five years of age and older. (a) Any rates, rating schedules.
- 5 five years of age and older. (a) Any rates, rating schedules,
- 6 or rating manuals for the liability, personal injury protection,
- 7 and collision coverages of a motor vehicle insurance policy
- 8 submitted to or filed with the insurance commissioner shall
- 9 provide for an appropriate reduction in premium charges as to
- 10 those coverages when the principal operator of the covered
- 11 vehicle is an insured fifty-five years of age or older for a
- 12 three-year period after successfully completing a motor vehicle
- 13 accident prevention course approved by the department of
- 14 transportation. Any discount used by an insurer shall be
- 15 presumed appropriate unless credible data demonstrates
- 16 otherwise.
- (b) The premium reduction required by this section shall
- 18 be effective for an insured for a three-year period after



- 1 successful completion of the approved course, except that the
- 2 insurer may require, as a condition of providing and maintaining
- 3 the discount, that the insured for the three-year period after
- 4 course completion not be involved in an accident for which the
- 5 insured is at fault.
- 6 (c) Upon successfully completing the approved course, each
- 7 person shall be issued a certificate by the organization
- 8 offering the course, which shall be used to qualify for the
- 9 premium discount required by this section.
- 10 (d) This section shall not apply in the event the approved
- 11 course is specified by a court or other governmental entity
- 12 resulting from a moving traffic violation.
- (e) Each participant shall take an approved course every
- 14 three years to continue to be eligible for the reduction in
- 15 premiums."
- 16 SECTION 2. New statutory material is underscored.
- 17 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
