A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO SCRAP METAL.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 445, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
- 3 and to read as follows:
- 4 "§445-A Special requirements for copper. In addition to
- 5 the requirements of section 445-233, every scrap dealer, when
- 6 purchasing copper from an individual, shall require the
- 7 individual to present valid identification and be fingerprinted
- 8 by the scrap dealer. The scrap dealer shall keep at the
- 9 dealer's place of business a copy of the seller's identification
- 10 and fingerprints for a period of two years after the date of
- 11 purchase. The copy of the identification and fingerprints may
- 12 be examined at any time by the chief of police or the chief's
- 13 designee."
- 14 SECTION 2. Section 445-234, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 15 amended to read as follows:
- 16 "\$445-234 Applicability. Any person required to be
- 17 licensed under chapter 289 or under section 445-171 shall not be

- 1 required to pay an additional fee under section 445-232;
- 2 provided that such person shall obtain the license required by
- 3 section 445-232 and shall follow the requirements of sections
- 4 445-232 [and], 445-233, and 445-A when acting as a scrap
- 5 dealer."
- 6 SECTION 3. Section 445-235, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 7 amended to read as follows:
- 8 "§445-235 Prohibitions; penalty. Any person who violates
- 9 sections 445-232 and $445-233[_{7}]$ or section 445-A, or any person
- 10 who falsifies a statement required by section 445-233[7] or
- 11 falsifies the identification required by section 445-A shall be
- 12 quilty of a misdemeanor."
- 13 SECTION 4. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 14 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 15 SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
