## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The purpose of this Act is to amend the
- 2 definition of "familial status" in section 515-2, Hawaii Revised
- 3 Statutes, to specify that a non-parent individual cohabiting
- 4 with any minor children must have the written consent of the
- 5 child's parent in order to qualify for "familial status" under
- 6 the state housing laws.
- 7 SECTION 2. Section 515-2, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 8 amended by amending the definition of "familial status" to read
- 9 as follows:
- 10 ""Familial status" means the status of: a parent having
- 11 legal custody of and [domiciled] cohabiting with a minor child
- 12 or children, a person who is [domiciled] cohabiting with a minor
- 13 child or children [and who has] pursuant to the express written
- 14 [or unwritten] permission [from] of the legal parent, a person
- 15 who is pregnant, or [any] a person cohabiting with a minor child
- 16 or children and who is in the process of securing the legal
- 17 custody of [a minor] the child or children."
