BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 84-11, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended to read as follows:
- 3 "§84-11 Gifts. (a) No legislator or employee shall
- 4 solicit, accept, or receive, directly or indirectly, any gift,
- 5 whether in the form of money, service, loan, travel,
- 6 entertainment, hospitality, thing, or promise, or in any other
- 7 form, under circumstances in which it can reasonably be inferred
- 8 that the gift is intended to influence the legislator or
- 9 employee in the performance of the legislator's or employee's
- 10 official duties or is intended as a reward for any official
- 11 action on the legislator's or employee's part.
- 12 (b) Solicitation, acceptance, or receipt, directly or
- 13 indirectly, of any gift, whether in the form of money, service,
- 14 loan, travel, entertainment, hospitality, thing, or promise, or
- 15 in any other form, by a legislator or employee from any
- 16 lobbyist, as defined in section 97-1, is prohibited."
