A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO SENIOR CENTERS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- SECTION 1. The legislature recognizes that senior centers in our islands, among other things, provide invaluable services
- 3 to seniors that encompass a host of social, educational, and
- 4 cultural opportunities, as well as activities that support
- 5 healthy lifestyles. The purpose of this Act is to support the
- 6 operations of certain senior centers on Oahu so that they may
- 7 continue to enhance the quality of senior life in their
- 8 respective communities.
- 9 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
- 10 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$416,000 or so much
- 11 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2008-2009 to provide
- 12 funding for grants pursuant to chapter 42F, Hawaii Revised
- 13 Statutes, to be allocated as follows:
- 14 (a) \$170,000 to Catholic Charities Hawaii for the
- operation of the Lanakila Multi-Purpose Senior Center;
- 16 (b) \$80,000 to the Kapahulu Center;
- 17 (c) \$85,000 to the Moiliili Community Center; and

- 1 (d) \$81,000 to the Waikiki Community Center.
- 2 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
- 3 health for the purposes of this Act.
- 4 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2008.
