A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE UNIVERSITY OF HAWAII.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The University of Hawaii at Manoa campus has
- 2 provided leadership in sustainability and energy efficiency,
- 3 beginning with the chancellor's energy summit in October 2006.
- 4 With the leadership of the faculty and students, the Manoa
- 5 campus has continued to pursue ways to reduce energy use and
- 6 have committed to developing models for campus energy savings
- 7 that can benefit the entire university and the broader
- 8 community.
- 9 Building on this commitment, the sustainable Saunders
- 10 project was adopted as a pilot demonstration for campus energy
- 11 savings by the Manoa sustainability council and over fifty
- 12 students have since joined the effort to work on various
- 13 projects from recycling to establishing a website to engage more
- 14 campus residents.
- 15 The sustainable Saunders project seeks to make Saunders
- 16 hall, a seven story concrete building that houses twelve
- 17 academic departments, research units, classrooms, and staff

- 1 offices, a livable, sustainable, quality home to faculty, staff,
- 2 and students. Saunders hall is a major user of energy on the
- 3 Manoa campus, using approximately 2.4 million kilowatt hours
- 4 annually. At the current cost of approximately sixteen cents
- 5 per kilowatt hour, the annual energy cost is approximately
- 6 \$384,000. This is a cost that will only increase over time.
- 7 To address these concerns, Saunders hall sought and
- 8 obtained support from the Hawaii energy policy forum's energy by
- 9 example program, obtaining a preliminary energy efficiency
- 10 audit. The audit recommendations, if funded, can reduce or
- 11 offset the building's energy load by an estimated thirty-nine
- 12 per cent and would pay for itself in six and a half years. More
- 13 specifically, the current annual utility bill for Saunders hall
- 14 can be reduced by installing various conservation and renewable
- 15 energy measures, with a cost of \$1,024,000.
- 16 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
- 17 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$1,024,000 or so much
- 18 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2008-2009 for the
- 19 energy conservation and renewable energy measures that are part
- 20 of the sustainable Saunders project at the University of Hawaii
- 21 at Manoa.

- 1 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the University of
- 2 Hawaii for the purposes of this Act.
- 3 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2008.
