## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO EDUCATION.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that a shortage of school 2 supplies for the classroom and funds to purchase the supplies 3 has been an ongoing problem for many years. The legislature believes that to properly address this problem, purchasing power 4 5 should be concentrated at the classroom level: debit card 6 systems can be implemented so teachers can use the debit cards 7 for specific purchases within a set dollar limit. 8 The benefits of a debit card system include: 9 Streamlining the process by which teachers can (1) 10 purchase necessary school supplies and other related 11 curriculum support supplies, thereby eliminating the 12 time required to obtain a product and the time lag for 13 reimbursement of out-of-pocket expenses; and

(2) Providing teachers with flexibility for their purchases and allowing them to take advantage of school discounts and sales in the community.

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         The legislature further finds that there are banks that can
    assist with the establishment of debit card system accounts, at
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    little or no cost. The system can be set up to provide up-to-
