A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO PUBLIC LANDS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Chapter 171, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
3	and to read as follows:
4	"§171- Transiting public lands; commercial activity.
5	(a) No person shall transit unencumbered public lands for the
6	purpose of any commercial activity without first obtaining a
7	conservation district use permit, unless the unencumbered land
8	is within an area that is regulated through a management plan
9	that permits the commercial activity.
10	(b) When determining whether to grant a conservation
11	district use permit for a person to transit unencumbered public
12	lands for the purpose of a commercial activity, the board shall
13	consider whether:
14	(1) The commercial activity will have unreasonable adverse
15	health, environmental, or socio-economic effects;
16	(2) The commercial activity will unreasonably burden
17	public agencies to provide streets or roads, sewers,
18	water, drainage, and police; or

1	(3)	There are reasonable measures available to mitigate
2		the unreasonable adverse effects or burdens referred
3		to in paragraphs (1) and (2).
4	<u>(c)</u>	Nothing in this section shall be construed to apply
5	to:	
6	(1)	Personnel or agents of the department of land and
7		natural resources; or
8	(2)	Emergency personnel, including medical, fire, and
9		police personnel, in their official capacity.
10	<u>(d)</u>	Any person who violates this section shall be fined
11	not less	than \$100 or more than \$500.
12	(e)	As used in this section:
13	"Com	mercial activity" means to engage in any action or to
14	attempt t	o engage in any action for compensation in any form,
15	including	but not limited to providing, or attempting to
16	provide,	guide services, charters, tours, and transportation to
17	and from	the location for which services are provided.
18	"Tra	nsit" means to pass over or through.
19	<u>(f)</u>	The department shall adopt rules pursuant to chapter
20	01 to imm	lement and enforce this section "
