RELATING TO TRAFFIC VIOLATIONS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 291-12, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended to read as follows:
- 3 "§291-12 Inattention to driving. (a) Whoever operates
- 4 any vehicle without due care or in a manner as to cause a
- 5 collision with, or injury or damage to, as the case may be, any
- 6 person, vehicle or other property shall be fined not more than
- 7 \$500 or imprisoned not more than thirty days, or both.
- 8 (b) It shall be a violation under this section to use a
- 9 cellular telephone while operating any vehicle, unless the
- 10 cellular telephone is a hands-free device."
- 11 SECTION 2. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
- 12 matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
- 13 begun, before its effective date.
- 14 SECTION 3. New statutory material is underscored.
- 15 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
