BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- SECTION 1. Chapter 346, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is

 amended by adding a new section to part II to be appropriately

 designated and to read as follows:

 "§346- Psychiatric services; reimbursement rate.

 Beginning July 1, 2007, the reimbursement rate for psychiatric

 services shall be per cent of the seventy-fifth percentile
- 7 of the current Hawaii medicaid fee profile; provided that in any
- 8 county with a population of 200,000 or less, the reimbursement
- 9 rate for psychiatric services shall be per cent of the
- 10 seventy-fifth percentile of the current Hawaii medicaid fee
- profile."
- 12 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
- 13 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$, or so
- 14 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2007-2008, and
- 15 the same sum, or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal
- 16 year 2008-2009, for the medicaid program to cover the

- reimbursement rate increase provided for in section 1 of this
