A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO LANGUAGE ACCESS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 371-32, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 2 amended to read as follows: 3 "[+]\$371-32[+] Definitions. Whenever used in this part, 4 unless a different meaning clearly appears from the context: 5 ["Access or participate"] "Access" or "participate" means 6 to be informed of, participate in, and benefit from the 7 services, programs, and activities offered by the State and 8 covered entities. 9 "Covered entity" means a person or organization receiving 10 state financial assistance, including grants, purchase-of-11 service contracts, or any other arrangement by which the State 12 provides or otherwise makes available assistance in the form of 13 funds to the person or organization for the purpose of rendering 14 services [on behalf of the State.] to the public. It shall not 15 include procurement contracts, state insurance or guaranty 16 contracts, licenses, tax credits, or loan guarantees to private 17 businesses of general concern that do not render services on
- 18 behalf of the State.

- 1 "Language" means human speech or the expression of ideas by 2 written characters and includes systems used by nations, people, 3 or other distinct communities. 4 "Limited English proficient" means individuals who, on 5 account of national origin, do not speak English as their 6 primary language and who identify themselves [+]as[+] having a 7 limited ability to read, write, speak, or understand the English 8 language. 9 "Oral language services" means the free provision of oral 10 information necessary to enable limited English proficient 11 persons to access or participate in services, programs, or 12 activities[-] of a state agency or covered entity. 13 "Purchase-of-service contract" means any and all types of 14 formal written agreements, regardless of what they may be 15 called, between the State and another legal entity, to purchase 16 or otherwise acquire any service for the purpose of rendering 17 services to the public. 18 "State" or "state agency" means any department, office, 19 commission, board, or other agency of the executive, 20 legislative, [and] or judicial [branches of state government, 21 including departments, offices, commissions, boards, or other 22 agencies within the executive, legislative, or judicial
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branches.] branch of the State, including the office of Hawaiian

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         "Written language services" means the free provision of
    written information necessary to enable limited English
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    proficient persons to access or participate in services,
    programs, or activities of a state agency or covered entity."
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         SECTION 2. Section 371-34, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
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    amended by amending subsections (b) and (c) to read as follows:
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         "(b) Each state agency's plan for language access shall be
    established in consultation with the executive director of the
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    office of language access and the state agency's coordinator for
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    language access. State agencies receiving federal financial
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    assistance shall file an initial language access plan with the
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    executive director of the office of language access no later
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- 1 than July 1, 2007, and every two years thereafter. All other
- 2 state agencies shall file a language access plan with the
- 3 executive director of the office of language access no later
- 4 than July 1, 2008, and every two years thereafter. Each covered
- 5 entity shall file a language access plan with the executive
- 6 director of the office of language access no later than July 1,
- 7 2009, and every two years thereafter.
- 8 (c) Each state agency and covered entity shall designate a
- 9 language access coordinator who shall establish and implement
- 10 the plan for language access in consultation with the executive
- 11 director of the office of language access and the language
- 12 access advisory council."
- SECTION 3. Section 371-37, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 14 amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows:
- "(a) There is established the language access advisory
- 16 council within the department of labor and industrial relations
- 17 for administrative purposes. The council shall consist of the
- 18 following members to be appointed by the governor:
- 19 (1) One representative from the state government;
- 20 (2) One representative from a covered entity;
