A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO LANGUAGE ACCESS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- SECTION 1. Section 371-32, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 1 amended to read as follows: 2 3 "[+] §371-32[+] Definitions. Whenever used in this part, unless a different meaning clearly appears from the context: 4 ["Access or participate"] "Access" or "participate" means 5 6 to be informed of, participate in, and benefit from the services, programs, and activities offered by the State and 7 8 covered entities. "Covered entity" means a person or organization receiving 9 state financial assistance, including grants, purchase-of-10 service contracts, or any other arrangement by which the State 11 provides or otherwise makes available assistance in the form of 12 funds to the person or organization for the purpose of rendering 13 services [on behalf of the State.] to the public. It shall not 14 15 include procurement contracts, state insurance or guaranty contracts, licenses, tax credits, or loan guarantees to private 16 businesses of general concern that do not render services on 17
- 18 behalf of the State.

- 1 "Language" means human speech or the expression of ideas by
- 2 written characters and includes systems used by nations, people,
- 3 or other distinct communities.
- 4 "Limited English proficient" means individuals who, on
- 5 account of national origin, do not speak English as their
- 6 primary language and who identify themselves [+]as[+] having a
- 7 limited ability to read, write, speak, or understand the English
- 8 language.
- 9 "Oral language services" means the free provision of oral
- 10 information necessary to enable limited English proficient
- 11 persons to access or participate in services, programs, or
- 12 activities [-] of a state agency or covered entity.
- "Purchase-of-service contract" means any and all types of
- 14 formal written agreements, regardless of what they may be
- 15 called, between the State and any person, to purchase or
- 16 otherwise acquire any service for the purpose of rendering
- 17 services to the public.
- 18 "State" or "state agency" means the executive, legislative,
- 19 [and] or judicial branches of state government, including
- 20 departments, offices, commissions, boards, or other agencies
- 21 within the executive, legislative, or judicial branches.

12	SECT	ION 2. Section 371-37, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
13	amended by	y amending subsection (a) to read as follows:
14	"(a)	There is established the language access advisory
15	council w	ithin the department of labor and industrial relations
16	for admin	istrative purposes. The council shall consist of the
17	following	members to be appointed by the governor:
18	(1)	One representative from the state government;
19	(2)	One representative from a covered entity;
20	(3)	One bilingual case management worker, or an individual
21		who is or has been employed by a state-funded
22		immigrant service agency or program;

1	(4)	One representative of an advocacy organization that
2		provides services to limited English proficient
3		persons;
4	(5)	One member from the limited English proficient
5		population who has an interest in the provision of
6		oral language services;
7	(6)	One representative of the University of Hawaii
8		department of language and linguistics who provides
9		professional training in interpretation and
10		translation;
11	(7)	One representative of a Hawaiian language advocacy
12		organization;
13	(8)	One representative of a professional interpreter's
14		organization;
15	(9)	One representative of a bilingual referral service or
16		program;
17	(10)	One representative residing in the county of Hawaii;
18	(11)	One representative residing in the county of Kauai;
19	(12)	One representative residing in the county of Maui;
20	(13)	One representative residing in the city and county of
21		Oahu;

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[(10)] (14) The executive director of the Hawaii civil
rights commission or authorized representative[; and],

as ex-officio member; and

[(11)] (15) The executive director, as ex-officio member."
