BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 436B, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 2 amended by adding a new section in part VI to be appropriately 3 designated and to read as follows: 4 Unlawful influence of appraisers. (a) Pursuant "§436B-5 to section 466K- , any licensee with an interest in a real 6 estate transaction involving an appraisal shall not improperly 7 influence the development, reporting, result, or review of a 8 real estate appraisal if the licensee's compensation is 9 dependent on or affected by the value conclusion generated by 10 the appraisal. 11 (b) If a licensee violates section 466K- , the director, 12 after a hearing in accordance with chapter 91, may order one or 13 more of the following remedies as appropriate relief: 14 (1)Refund the money paid as fees for services; Correct the work done in providing services; 15 (2) 16 Revoke the license or certificate; (3)

Suspend the license or certificate;

(3) 2 (c) If a licensee violates this section within the course 3 and scope of the duties as a licensee, the licensee shall be 4 disciplined under section 436B-5 (d) Nothing in this section shall be construed to authorize communications that are not otherwise prohibited under 6 7 existing law. 8 (e) For the purposes of this section, "licensee" means any 9 person holding a license who is subject to this chapter or chapter 444, 454, 464, 467, or 467A." 10 11 SECTION 3. This Act does not affect rights and duties that 12 matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were 13 begun, before its effective date. 14 SECTION 4.
