A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE LEGISLATURE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The Hawaii Revised Statutes is amended by

2 adding a new chapter to be appropriately designated and to read

3 as follows:

4 "CHAPTER

JOINT LEGISLATIVE INFORMATION COMMITTEE

- 6 § -1 Joint legislative information committee
- 7 **established.** There shall be established a joint legislative
- 8 information committee. The committee shall ascertain facts and
- 9 make recommendations to the legislature and the houses thereof
- 10 concerning the legislature's computer system and network, and
- 11 any other matters as may be provided in the rules of the senate
- 12 and the rules of the house. The committee shall have continuing
- 13 existence and may meet, act, and conduct its business at any
- 14 place within the State, during any session of the legislature,
- 15 any recess, and any interim period between sessions.
- 16 § -2 Selection of members; co-chairpersons; filling
- 17 vacancies. The committee shall consist of five members of the

- 1 senate and five members of the house who shall be selected in a
- 2 manner provided for in the rules of the senate and the rules of
- 3 the house. The president of the senate and the speaker of the
- 4 house shall select the members of the committee, including
- 5 members of the majority leadership and members of the minority
- 6 leadership. The senate members of the committee shall elect a
- 7 co-chair from among the senate members. The house members of
- 8 the committee shall elect a co-chair from among the house
- 9 members. Vacancies occurring in the membership of the committee
- 10 shall be filled in a manner provided by the rules of the senate
- 11 and the rules of the house. A vacancy shall be deemed to exist
- 12 as to any member of the committee whose term is expiring
- 13 whenever the member is not reelected at the general election.
- 14 § -3 Rules. The committee may adopt rules governing its
- 15 own proceedings and to create subcommittees from its membership
- 16 and to assign the subcommittees to any study, inquiry,
- 17 investigation, or hearing that the committee itself has
- 18 authority to undertake or to hold.
- 19 § -4 Office of legislative information established.
- 20 There is established the office of legislative information to be
- 21 administered by the committee. The committee shall appoint a
- 22 chief legislative information officer to oversee and manage the

- 1 office of legislative information and who shall serve for a
- 2 period of four years. The committee, by three-fourths vote of
- 3 its members, may remove the chief legislative information
- 4 officer from office, but only for cause. The committee shall
- 5 fix the salary of the chief legislative information officer.
- 6 § -5 General purpose of the office of legislative
- 7 information. The purpose of the office of legislative
- 8 information office shall be to:
- 9 (1) Oversee and manage the legislative computer system and
- 10 network;
- 11 (2) Provide the legislature with computer network and
- 13 (3) Provide the legislature with systems analysis;
- 14 (4) Provide analysts and programmers to develop and
- 15 maintain any network or computer programs, systems, or
- applications used by the legislature;
- 17 (5) Maintain the legislature's website; and
- 18 (6) Assist the legislature with general computer problems
- 19 and computer-related needs.
- 20 **§ -6 Staff.** The chief legislative information officer
- 21 shall appoint employees as may be necessary to carry out the
- 22 functions of the office of legislative information. All

- 1 employees shall serve at the chief information officer's
- 2 pleasure. In determining the salary of employees of the office
- 3 of legislative information, the chief legislative information
- 4 officer shall consult with the department of human resources
- 5 development and the committee. The chief legislative
- 6 information officer and the employees of the office of
- 7 legislative information shall be entitled to participate in any
- 8 employee benefit program plan or privilege."
- 9 SECTION 2. Chapter 21F, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 10 repealed.
- 11 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
