RELATING TO ELECTIONS.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 12-2, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended to read as follows:
- 3 "\$12-2 Primary held when; candidates only those nominated.
- 4 The primary shall be held at the polling place for each precinct
- 5 on the second to the last Saturday of September in every even
- 6 numbered year; provided that in no case shall any primary
- 7 election precede a general election by less than forty-five
- 8 days.
- 9 [No] Except with regard to the lieutenant governor pursuant
- 10 to article V, section 2 of the State constitution, no person
- 11 shall be a candidate for any general or special general election
- 12 unless the person has been nominated in the immediately
- 13 preceding primary or special primary."
- 14 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 15 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 16 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon ratification of
- 17 a constitutional amendment requiring that candidates for the



- office of lieutenant governor be nominated by a political party 1
- 2 at the political party's convention.
