A BILL FOR AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION TO THE JUDICIAL SELECTION COMMISSION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The judicial selection commission reviews and
- 2 evaluates applicants for all judicial vacancies, selects the
- 3 qualified nominees, and then forwards the names of the nominees
- 4 to the appropriate appointing authority. The judicial selection
- 5 commission is an independent, constitutionally-created entity
- 6 and, pursuant to article VI, section 4 of the Constitution of
- 7 the State of Hawaii, is attached to the judiciary branch for
- 8 administrative support only.
- 9 While article VI, section 4 of the Constitution of the
- 10 State of Hawaii requires that the legislature "provide for the
- 11 staff and operating expenses of the judicial selection
- 12 commission in a separate budget," the judicial selection
- 13 commission, in prior years, has not presented its own budget
- 14 request to the legislature. Funding for the judicial selection
- 15 commission has generally been included as part of the
- 16 judiciary's budget.

- 1 For example, in fiscal years 2007-2008 and 2008-2009, the
- 2 judicial selection commission's operations were funded by the
- 3 Judiciary Appropriations Act of 2007, Act 169, Session Laws of
- 4 Hawaii 2007 (Act 169). As part of the appropriations made in
- 5 section 3 of Act 169, in JUD601 ADMINISTRATION, the judicial
- 6 selection commission received a general fund appropriation of
- 7 \$94,283 for fiscal year 2007-2008, and a general fund
- 8 appropriation of \$94,283 for fiscal year 2008-2009.
- 9 The attorney general has advised the judicial selection
- 10 commission that as article VI, section 4 of the Constitution of
- 11 the State of Hawaii literally provides that the judicial
- 12 selection commission should prepare and submit its own budget
- 13 request to the legislature so that the judicial selection
- 14 commission's budget appropriations are independent of the
- 15 judiciary's budget appropriations.
- 16 The purpose of this Act is to appropriate funds for the
- 17 judicial selection commission's operations for fiscal year 2008-
- 18 2009.
- 19 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
- 20 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$94,283 or so much
- 21 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2008-2009 for the
- 22 staffing and operation of the judicial selection commission.



- 1 One position at 1.0 FTE is authorized for the judicial selection
- 2 commission for fiscal year 2008-2009; provided that this
- 3 position may be filled without regard to chapters 76 and 89,
- 4 Hawaii Revised Statutes, and shall serve at the pleasure of the
- 5 commission.
- 6 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the judicial
- 7 selection commission for the purposes of this Act.
- 8 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2008.
