A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CRIMINAL IMPERSONATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 707, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
- 3 and to read as follows:
- 4 "\$707- Criminal impersonation. (1) A person commits
- 5 the offense of criminal impersonation if the person, while
- 6 impersonating another, makes or causes to be made, either
- 7 directly or indirectly, a transmission of any information about
- 8 the other that the person does not believe to be true, by any
- 9 oral statement, any written statement, or any statement conveyed
- 10 by any electronic means, with the intent to cause bodily injury
- 11 to the other person or in reckless disregard of the risk of
- 12 causing bodily injury to the other person.
- (2) Criminal impersonation is a class C felony."
- 14 SECTION 2. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
- 15 matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
- 16 begun, before its effective date.
- 17 SECTION 3. New statutory material is underscored.
- 18 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2050.
