A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO EXTRACURRICULAR ACTIVITIES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 302A, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
- 3 and to read as follows:
- 4 "§302A- Participation in extracurricular activities by
- 5 home schooled children. (a) As used in this section,
- 6 "extracurricular activity" means a school authorized or
- 7 education-related activity occurring during or outside the
- 8 regular instructional school day, including, but not limited to,
- 9 sports, cheerleading, music, band, clubs, and other programs.
- 10 (b) A child who is home schooled in accordance with
- 11 section 302A-1132 is eligible to participate in extra curricular
- 12 activities at the public school that the child would otherwise
- 13 be required to attend. A home schooled child who wishes to
- 14 participate in an extracurricular activity must meet the
- 15 participation requirements and restrictions for that activity,
- 16 including, but not limited to, maintaining appropriate grade
- 17 point averages and paying appropriate fees, so long as such

1	requirements or restrictions are not inconsistent with this
2	section.
3	(c) The department shall adopt rules to effectuate this
4	section and to provide procedures by which a home schooled child
5	may apply to participate in extracurricular activities. The
6	department may also adopt rules setting forth which programs
7	qualify as extracurricular activities under this section."
8	SECTION 2. New statutory material is underscored.
9	SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
