## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE JUDICIARY.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- SECTION 1. For the purpose of providing enhanced customer
- 2 service to the general public, the judiciary shall establish a
- 3 program for counties that consist of more than three islands
- 4 that allows for remote processing of citations for traffic
- 5 violations under chapters 291 and 291C, Hawaii Revised Statutes.
- 6 The remote processing shall only be allowed for first time
- 7 offenses and shall be in addition to any procedures provided in
- 8 chapter 291D, Hawaii Revised Statutes.
- 9 The judiciary shall report to the legislature on the remote
- 10 processing of citations for traffic violations under this Act,
- 11 including any proposed legislation, no later than twenty days
- 12 prior to the regular session of 2009.
- 13 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
- 14 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so
- 15 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2008-2009 for
- 16 establishing a program in counties that consist of more than

- 1 three islands, which allows for remote processing of citations
- 2 for first-time traffic violations.
- 3 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the judiciary for
- 4 the purposes of this Act.
- 5 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval;
- 6 provided that section 2 shall take effect on July 1, 2008.
