## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO MOLOKAI GENERAL HOSPITAL.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Molokai General Hospital is a critical access
- 2 hospital and the only hospital on the island of Molokai, serving
- 3 a population of approximately seven thousand five hundred
- 4 residents and all visitors. The hospital is a fifteen-bed
- 5 facility and represents the only twenty-four hour emergency
- 6 services, acute medical and pediatric inpatient care, midwifery
- 7 (obstetrical) care, radiology, CT scan, laboratory, and
- 8 respiratory therapy services on Molokai.
- 9 In addition, it provides mammography and ultrasound,
- 10 comprehensive physical therapy services, family planning,
- 11 hospice-comfort care, and specialty clinics including endoscopic
- 12 procedures. Molokai General Hospital's rural health clinic is
- 13 one of only five sites in Hawaii (and the only one on Molokai)
- 14 with a program certified by the American Diabetes Association
- 15 for diabetes care management. The rural health clinic also
- 16 houses the only chemotherapy services on Molokai, an almost

- 1 four-year-old program that has greatly eased the psychological
- 2 and financial burden of cancer in this community.
- 3 Although Molokai General Hospital is not a state hospital,
- 4 it receives a monthly subsidy from the State as a community
- 5 hospital. Molokai General Hospital also receives substantial
- 6 financial and management support as a subsidiary of The Queen's
- 7 Health Systems.
- 8 Molokai General Hospital has identified a need for a new
- 9 x-ray unit. The present x-ray unit is almost fourteen years
- 10 old, and in terms of advances in technology during that period,
- 11 it is ancient. A modern x-ray unit for Molokai General Hospital
- 12 would:
- 13 (1) Reduce the amount of developing chemicals used in
- 14 processing;
- 15 (2) Provide more detailed images especially of obese
- patients;
- 17 (3) Improve the overall quality of images;
- 18 (4) Digitally send images for reading in a more timely
- 19 manner, resulting in more accurate and better
- 20 information for physicians and enabling them to
- 21 provide the best possible patient diagnosis and the
- 22 best possible outcomes; and

- 1 (5) Greatly reduce time the unit is not in service, which
  2 is imperative as the only 24-7 radiology service on
  3 the island.
- 4 Molokai General Hospital is a Hawaii nonprofit corporation.
- 5 This appropriation would help Molokai General Hospital to meet
- 6 the on-going needs of the population of the island of Molokai
- 7 and would help assure the health, safety, and welfare of
- 8 residents of and visitors to the island of Molokai. For these
- 9 reasons, the purpose of this Act is to appropriate \$400,000, as
- 10 a grant pursuant to chapter 42F, Hawaii Revised Statutes, for
- 11 the purchase of an x-ray unit for Molokai General Hospital.
- 12 The legislature finds and declares that this Act is in the
- 13 public interest and for the public health, safety, and welfare.
- 14 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
- 15 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$400,000 or so much
- 16 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2008-2009 as a grant
- 17 pursuant to chapter 42F, Hawaii Revised Statutes, to purchase an
- 18 x-ray unit for Molokai General Hospital.
- 19 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
- 20 health for the purposes of this Act.
- 21 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2008.
