# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO INSURANCE.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 286-108.4, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 2 amended to read as follows: 3 "[-f] \$286-108.4 Driver education and behind-the-wheel 4 driver training program. [+] The director of transportation is 5 directed to establish and certify a statewide driver education program and behind-the-wheel driver training program, to include 6 the number of course hours, curriculum, and certification of 7 8 teachers and third-party examiners [-], and an optional accident 9 prevention program for purposes of section 431:10C-207. The 10 director of transportation is also directed to set a cost for 11 the programs to enable the programs to be self-sufficient. The director of transportation shall adopt rules pursuant to chapter 12 13 91 necessary for the purposes of this [4] section[4]." 14 SECTION 2. Section 431:10C-207, Hawaii Revised Statutes, 15 is amended to read as follows: "§431:10C-207 Discriminatory practices prohibited[+]; 16 17 accident prevention program; exception. (a) No insurer shall
