## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO PROPERTY INSURANCE.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that homeowners in Hawaii
- 2 have been unable to obtain basic property insurance solely
- 3 because of the age of their homes.
- 4 The legislature has established the Hawaii property
- 5 insurance association, a nonprofit unincorporated legal entity
- 6 whose membership consists of all insurers authorized to offer
- 7 property insurance in Hawaii. Each member insurer participates
- 8 in the writings, expenses, profits, and losses of the Hawaii
- 9 property insurance association. The purpose of the Hawaii
- 10 property insurance association is to ensure the availability of
- 11 basic property insurance for owners of property in high risk
- 12 areas for major natural disasters.
- 13 The purpose of this Act is to expand the scope of persons
- 14 to whom the Hawaii property insurance association is required to
- 15 provide coverage to property owners unable to obtain basic
- 16 property insurance because of the age of the dwelling, if the
- 17 dwelling is otherwise structurally sound and not condemnable.
