A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO INVASIVE SPECIES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that agriculture and
- 2 conservation organizations in the State are fighting to slow
- 3 down the invasion of alien species that are spreading from home
- 4 and commercial landscapes into agricultural areas and native
- 5 forests.
- 6 Under section 150A-6.1, Hawaii Revised Statutes, the
- 7 department of agriculture is required to maintain a list of
- 8 restricted plants that require a permit for entry into the
- 9 State. The department is currently in the process of updating
- 10 its restricted plant list pursuant to that section of law.
- 11 Under chapter 152, Hawaii Revised Statutes, the department of
- 12 agriculture is responsible for establishing criteria and
- 13 procedures for the designation of plant species as noxious
- 14 weeds, and is required to publish and make available a list of
- 15 noxious weeds to interested persons. While these statutory
- 16 provisions provide restrictions on the importation and control
- 17 of plants designated restricted, restrictions are not provided

- 1 for the sale of these restricted plants, which include noxious
- 2 weeds.
- 3 The legislature further finds that to help prevent further
- 4 introductions of invasive species in the State, additional
- 5 restrictions are needed to prevent the sale of plants designated
- 6 on the restricted plant or noxious weed list. Additionally,
- 7 further clarification is necessary to recognize that designated
- 8 restricted plants can be pests or can be hosts for pests such as
- 9 insects or pathogens.
- 10 The purpose of this Act is to allow the department of
- 11 agriculture to prohibit the sale of plants designated as
- 12 restricted plants, prohibit the sale of noxious weeds in the
- 13 State, and to recognize that designated restricted plants can be
- 14 pests or can be hosts for pests.
- 15 SECTION 2. Section 150A-6.1, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 16 amended to read as follows:
- 17 "\$150A-6.1 Plant import. (a) The board shall maintain a
- 18 list of restricted plants that require a permit for entry into
- 19 the State. Restricted plants or any portion thereof shall not
- 20 be imported into the State without a permit issued pursuant to
- 21 rules.

- 1 (b) The department shall designate, by rule, as restricted
- 2 plants, specific plants that may be detrimental or potentially
- 3 harmful, or that spread or may be likely to spread an
- 4 infestation or infection of an insect, pest, or disease that is
- 5 detrimental or potentially harmful to agriculture, horticulture,
- 6 the environment, or animal or public health. In addition, plant
- 7 species designated by rule as noxious weeds are designated as
- 8 restricted plants.
- 9 (c) The department, by rule, may regulate or prohibit the
- 10 sale of specific plants on the list of restricted plants.
- 11 (d) Noxious weeds may be imported only for research, by
- 12 permit, and shall not be offered for sale or sold in the State.
- 13 [(c)] (e) No person shall import, offer for sale, or sell
- 14 within the State any plant or propagative portion of Salvinia
- 15 molesta or Salvinia minima and [pistia] Pistia stratiotes.
- 16 [plants or portion thereof within the State.]"
- 17 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 18 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 19 SECTION 4. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
- 20 matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
- 21 begun, before its effective date.
- 22 SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
