## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO DENTAL CARE.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. In 2006, the legislature appropriated funds to 2 the department of human services to restore specific preventive 3 and restorative dental services for eligible persons twenty-one years of age or older under the State's medicaid and QUEST 4 programs. Previously, dental coverage for eligible adults was 5 6 limited to dental emergencies. According to a recent department of health report, each eligible adult can receive specific 7 preventive and restorative services, including dentures, 8 9 equivalent to \$500. However, this does not include coverage for endodontic care, root canals, crowns, elective procedures, or 10 periodontal surgery. Also, partial and full dentures generally 11 12 cost more than \$500. The purposes of this Act are to: 13 Expand coverage under medicaid and QUEST to include 14 (1)

(1) Expand coverage under medicaid and QUEST to include comprehensive dental care coverage for eligible persons twenty-one years of age or older and to appropriate funds to provide the additional coverage;

- 21 legislature no later than twenty days prior to the convening of



- 1 the 2009 regular session. The task force shall cease to exist
- upon the adjournment sine die of the 2009 regular session. 2
- 3 SECTION 7. New statutory material is underscored.
- 4 SECTION 8. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2008;
- provided that section 6 shall take effect upon its approval. 5
