## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO DENTAL HEALTH.

### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that inadequate dental 2 care is a serious matter and has been identified as a major
- 3 health concern for low-income adults and children, individuals
- 4 with developmental disabilities, and the uninsured. These
- 5 individuals continually face great challenges in obtaining
- 6 dental care services in an appropriate and timely manner, and
- 7 the legislature finds this situation to be unacceptable.
- 8 The legislature further finds that federally qualified
- ${f 9}$  health centers are the most appropriate and efficient entities
- 10 in which to establish community-based dental clinics that will
- 11 provide a continuum of dental care based on best practices for
- 12 QUEST and medicaid fee-for-service eligible adults and children,
- 13 individuals with developmental disabilities, and the uninsured.
- 14 The purpose of this Act is to improve the State's ability
- 15 to address this dental health crisis by appropriating funds to
- 16 the department of health for the establishment or expansion of

- 1 community-based dental health clinics operated by federally
- 2 qualified health centers to serve this population.
- 3 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
- 4 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so much
- 5 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2008-2009 to
- 6 establish or expand community-based dental health clinics
- 7 operated by federally qualified health centers to provide a
- 8 continuum of dental care to QUEST and medicaid fee-for-service
- 9 eligible adults and children, individuals with developmental
- 10 disabilities, and the uninsured.
- 11 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
- 12 health for the purposes of this Act.
- 13 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2008.
