A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO ELECTRIC AUTOMOBILES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. (a) The department of business, economic
2	development, and tourism shall develop an implementation plan to
3	increase electric, hybrid electric, plug-in hybrid, and energy-
4	efficient automobile use in Hawaii.
5	(b) In creating the plan, the department of business,
6	economic development, and tourism shall confer and consult with
7	the automobile industry, governmental agencies, and other
8	interested parties.
9	The plan shall have the following objectives:
10	(1) By 2015, ten per cent of the new automobiles imported
11	into the State shall be required to be powered by
12	electricity or alternative fuel; and
13	(2) By 2025, twenty per cent of the new automobiles
14	imported into the State shall be required to be
15	powered by electricity or alternative fuel.

- 1 The plan shall include the development of infrastructure to
- 2 support the widespread use of electric, plug-in hybrid, and
- 3 energy-efficient automobiles.
- 4 (c) For purposes of this section:
- 5 "Alternative fuel" has the same meaning as defined in 10
- 6 Code of Federal Regulations Part 490 (61 FR 10653, Mar. 14,
- 7 1996, as amended at 64 FR 26829, May 17, 1999).
- 8 "Electric automobile" shall mean an automobile that uses an
- 9 electric motor and motor controller instead of an internal
- 10 combustion engine.
- "Energy-efficient" or "energy-efficient vehicle" has the
- 12 same meaning as "energy-efficient vehicle", as defined in
- 13 section 103D-412, Hawaii Revised Statutes.
- 14 "Hybrid electric automobile" shall mean an automobile that
- 15 combines a conventional propulsion system with an on-board
- 16 internal rechargeable energy storage system to achieve better
- 17 fuel economy than a conventional automobile.
- 18 "Plug-in hybrid automobile" shall mean a hybrid automobile
- 19 with batteries that are recharged by an external electric power
- 20 source.
- 21 SECTION 2. The department of business, economic
- 22 development, and tourism shall submit the implementation plan to

- 1 the legislature no later than twenty days prior to the convening
- 2 of the 2009 regular session.
- 3 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
