## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE JUDICIARY.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. For the purpose of providing enhanced customer
- 2 service to the general public, the judiciary shall establish a
- 3 program for counties whose land area is greater than 4,000
- 4 square miles that allows for remote processing of citations for
- 5 traffic violations under chapters 291 and 291C, Hawaii Revised
- 6 Statutes. The remote processing shall only be allowed for first
- 7 time offenses and shall be in addition to any procedures
- 8 provided in chapter 291D, Hawaii Revised Statutes.
- 9 The judiciary shall report to the legislature, including
- 10 any proposed legislation, no later than twenty days prior to the
- 11 regular session of 2009.
- 12 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
- 13 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so
- 14 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2008-2009 for
- 15 establishing a program that allows for remote processing of
- 16 citations for first-time traffic violations.

- 1 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the judiciary for
- 2 the purposes of this Act.
- 3 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval;
- 4 provided that section 2 shall take effect on July 1, 2008.
