A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO EXECUTIVE MEETINGS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The purpose of this Act is to enhance Hawaii's
- 2 sunshine law and foster public trust in the government by
- 3 requiring that any votes on matters discussed during an
- 4 executive meeting be publicly taken at a subsequent open
- 5 meeting. Further, this Act adds provisions requiring that the
- 6 reason for an executive meeting be accompanied by a description
- 7 of the agenda items and statutory exception pursuant to section
- 8 92-5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, that justifies the executive
- 9 meeting. Meeting minutes must be provided within thirty days
- 10 but may be redacted to protect confidential information
- 11 specified in section 92-5, Hawaii Revised Statutes.
- 12 SECTION 2. Section 92-4, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 13 amended to read as follows:
- 14 "§92-4 Executive meetings. A board may hold an executive
- 15 meeting closed to the public upon an affirmative vote, taken at
- 16 an open meeting, of two-thirds of the members present; provided
- 17 the affirmative vote constitutes a majority of the members to

- 1 which the board is entitled. A meeting closed to the public
- 2 shall be limited to matters exempted by section 92-5. The
- 3 reason, description of agenda items, and the statutory exemption
- 4 pursuant to section 92-5 for holding such a meeting, shall be
- 5 publicly announced and the vote of each member on the question
- 6 of holding a meeting closed to the public shall be recorded, and
- 7 entered into the minutes of the meeting. Any votes on matters
- 8 discussed during executive meetings shall be publicly taken at a
- 9 subsequent open meeting of the board."
- 10 SECTION 3. Section 92-9, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 11 amended by amending subsection (b) to read as follows:
- "(b) The minutes shall be public records and shall be
- 13 available within thirty days after the meeting [except where
- 14 such disclosure would be inconsistent with section 92-5;
- 15 provided that minutes of executive meetings may be withheld so
- 16 long as their publication would defeat the lawful purpose of the
- 17 executive meeting, but no longer]. Where such disclosure would
- 18 expose confidential information specified in section 92-5 that
- 19 was the subject of an executive meeting, that information may be
- 20 redacted prior to public release."
- 21 SECTION 4. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 22 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
