A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE UNIVERSITY OF HAWAII.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the State has a
- 2 responsibility to conserve and protect agricultural lands,
- 3 promote diversified agriculture, increase agricultural self-
- 4 sufficiency, and ensure the availability of agriculturally
- 5 suitable lands that is mandated by article XI, section 3, of the
- 6 state constitution.
- 7 The legislature passed Act 183, Session Laws of Hawaii 2005
- 8 that provided a framework to designate important agricultural
- 9 lands after appropriate incentives are established. This
- 10 process may take several more years. Meanwhile, many
- 11 agricultural acres that would be considered important are
- 12 currently available for sale including land in the Kunia area on
- 13 Oahu.
- 14 Having the highest population in the State, Oahu's
- 15 agricultural lands are under extreme development pressure.
- 16 Thousands of agricultural acres in the Ewa plain are already
- 17 converted or destined to be converted to urban needs. However,

- 1 residents of Ewa and central Oahu have indicated in their
- 2 sustainable community plans their desire to maintain an
- 3 agricultural area.
- 4 There is an agricultural area of approximately 8,000
- 5 contiguous acres of valuable Hawaii farmland in the Ewa, central
- 6 Oahu area that is being purchased by companies which will
- 7 provide for a diverse mix of farming operations accommodating
- 8 large and small operations. Most importantly, the land owner
- 9 has indicated a willingness to contribute to the Hawaii
- 10 Agriculture Research Center approximately 119 acres of land and
- 11 improvements including agricultural worker housing and existing
- 12 facilities for agricultural offices and agribusinesses.
- 13 The Hawaii Farm Bureau Federation, Hawaii Agriculture
- 14 Research Center, the Agricultural Leadership Foundation of
- 15 Hawaii and the Landscape Industry Council of Hawaii are
- 16 interested in co-locating their operations at this site to share
- 17 business related resource needs. The University of Hawaii,
- 18 college of tropical agriculture and human resources is also
- 19 interested in utilizing this site to locate its agricultural
- 20 business incubator, its Poamoho field station, and for some of
- 21 its extension service office needs.

- Various agribusinesses have also expressed an interest in 1 having long term leases and locating and expanding their 2 3 businesses at this location. There is presently a rare opportunity to develop an 4 agricultural business complex where existing agriculturally-5 based businesses can develop further, while new agricultural 6 businesses can be incubated and provided the support to develop. 7 Entrepreneurs would be encouraged to build agricultural 8 businesses if an agribusiness incubator is located near their 9 property to provide needed assistance and to identify, test, and 10 11 develop new agribusiness products. The development of new agricultural businesses, supporting 12 infrastructure, and resulting agricultural products would 13 increase agricultural employment to support the existing 14 agricultural rental housing already located within this area. 15 The legislature finds that the acquisition of the subject 16 land for usage by the University of Hawaii, college of tropical 17 agriculture and human resources will further the State's 18 responsibility to promote diversified agriculture and increased 19
