A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO IRRIGATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. A reliable irrigation system is the lifeblood
- 2 of Hawaii's agricultural industry. To ensure that Hawaii's
- 3 crops receive a steady and dependable supply of water,
- 4 sufficient funding is needed to maintain and improve Hawaii's
- 5 irrigation systems.
- 6 The purpose of this Act is to provide additional funding
- 7 needed for the repair and maintenance of irrigation systems
- 8 throughout the state, including additional personnel for the
- 9 department of agriculture to improve oversight and management of
- 10 the irrigation systems.
- 11 SECTION 2. The director of finance is authorized to issue
- 12 general obligation bonds in the sum of \$ or so much
- 13 thereof as may be necessary and the same sum or so much thereof
- 14 as may be necessary is appropriated for fiscal year 2008-2009 to
- 15 be deposited into the irrigation repair and maintenance special
- 16 fund and used for the purposes specified in section 3 of this
- 17 Act.
