RELATING TO THE CANCER RESEARCH SPECIAL FUND.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

6		special fund; and
7	(D)	1.25 cents per cigarette shall be deposited to
8		the credit of the emergency medical services
9		special fund established pursuant to section 321-

11	The department	shall provide an annual accounting of these
12	dispositions to	the legislature."
13	SECTION 2	Section 304A-2168, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
14	amended to read	d as follows:
15	"§304A-216	8 Hawaii cancer research special fund. (a)
16	There is establ	ished within the state treasury a special fund to
17	be known as the	Hawaii cancer research special fund to be
18	administered ar	nd expended by the University of Hawaii.
19	(b) The r	moneys in the special fund shall be used by the
20	University of F	Hawaii for the cancer research center of Hawaii's
21	research, [and]	operating expenses[-], and capital expenditures.

1 (c) The following shall be deposited into the special 2 fund: (1) Moneys collected pursuant to section 245-15; [and] 3 4 (2) All other fees, charges, and other moneys received in 5 conjunction with cancer center programs; 6 (3) Transfers from other accounts or funds; and 7 [+(2)] (4) Interest earned or accrued on moneys in the 8 special fund." 9 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed 10 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored. SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval. 11
