## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CHILD PROTECTION.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that grandparents are 2 part of the natural support system for a family. In addition to their familial relationship with the child, grandparents offer 3 4 other strengths and resources, such as life experience and 5 maturity. The rights, knowledge, and wisdom of a child's 6 grandparents can be instrumental to the effective conduct of certain hearings under chapter 587, Hawaii Revised Statutes, at 7 8 which decisions are made regarding the best interests of the child and the need for protective services. 9 10 The purpose of this Act is to give a child's grandparent an opportunity to participate as a party at certain child 11 protective hearings, thereby helping to ensure the safety and 12 13 well-being of the child. 14 SECTION 2. Section 587-51.5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 15 amended by amending subsections (b) and (c) to read as follows:
- 16 "(b) Notice of all hearings subsequent to the section
- 17 587-71 disposition hearing shall be served upon the current
- 18 foster parent or foster parents[7] and each grandparent who can

- 1 be located, each of whom shall be entitled to participate in the
- 2 proceedings as a party. Notice of hearings shall be served by
- 3 the department upon the current foster parent or foster parents
- 4 and each grandparent who can be located no less than forty-eight
- 5 hours before the scheduled hearing, subject to a shortening of
- 6 time when a hearing is set within a shorter time frame. No
- 7 hearing shall be held until the current foster parent or foster
- 8 parents [are] and each grandparent who can be located is served.
- 9 For purposes of this subsection, notice [to foster parents] may
- 10 be effected by hand delivery, regular mail, or by facsimile or
- 11 electronic mail if receipt may be confirmed, and may consist of
- 12 the last court order, if it includes the date and time of the
- 13 hearing.
- (c) For purposes of this section, "party" or "parties"
- 15 shall include the current foster parents [-] and grandparents."
- 16 SECTION 3. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
- 17 matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
- 18 begun, before its effective date.
- 19 SECTION 4. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 20 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

1 SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
