A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO AUTISM SPECTRUM DISORDERS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 431, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 2 amended by adding a new section to article 10A to be 3 appropriately designated and to read as follows: 4 "§431:10A- Autism spectrum disorder coverage. Each policy of accident and health or sickness insurance providing 5 6 health care coverage shall provide coverage for the diagnosis 7 and treatment of autism spectrum disorders for covered 8 individuals under the age of twenty-one years. 9 For purposes of this section: "Autism spectrum disorders" means any of the pervasive 10 11 developmental disorders as defined by the most recent edition of 12 the Diagnostic and Statistical Manual of Mental Disorders, including autistic disorder and Asperger's disorder. 13 14 "Diagnosis" means medically necessary assessments, 15 evaluations, or tests to diagnose whether an individual has an 16 autism spectrum disorder.
- "Medically necessary" means any care, treatment,
