RELATING TO GOVERNMENT OPERATIONS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. Section 92-5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 1 2 amended by amending subsection (b) to read as follows: 3 In no instance shall the board make a decision or deliberate toward a decision in an executive meeting on matters 4 5 not directly related to the purposes specified in subsection 6 (a) [-]; provided further that in no instance shall the board of 7 regents of the University of Hawaii withhold recommendations, draft documents, proposals, suggestions, or other opinion 8 9 materials that comprise part of the deliberative process by 10 which the board of regents formulates its decisions and 11 policies, including but not limited to, decisions relating to 12 the budget of the University of Hawaii system, any of its campuses, or any of its divisions. No chance meeting, permitted 13 interaction, or electronic communication shall be used to 14 15 circumvent the spirit or requirements of this part to make a decision or to deliberate toward a decision upon a matter over 16 which the board has supervision, control, jurisdiction, or 17

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advisory power."

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    university not subject to chapter 76 shall be under the

Denies the University of Hawaii the use of the deliberative process privilege in closing an agency meeting to the public. Specifies that the deliberative process privilege does not cover meetings related to the budget of the University of Hawaii. Requires the University of Hawaii to disclose beforehand the range of proposed compensation to executives, including head athletic coaches. Extends annual salary reporting requirement to include salaries of head athletic coaches.
